An acknowledgement of receipt of your submission will be sent to your e-mail address after the submission. Please consider that only abstracts corresponding to the editorial guidelines will enter the review process.

The material must not have been published or presented at any major meeting before. Abstract submissions will be accepted from January 31, 2007. Original contributions on any of the topics of the congress are welcome.

EDITORIAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL ABSTRACT SUBMISSION:

- The abstract language is English
- Abstracts must be submitted by e-mail as Word (.doc) attachment
- Type the abstracts in small letters (Arial 10)
- Type the title of the abstract in capital bold letters
- The text should not exceed 400 words. The use of tables or figures is not allowed
- The title of the abstract must be printed in CAPITAL LETTERS; the name(s) of the author(s) should be preceded by the initials (omit titles).
- Underline the name of the presenting author(s) only.
- The abstract must consist of four paragraphs labelled OBJECTIVE, METHODS, RESULTS, CONCLUSIONS. This does not apply to "Case reports".
- Mark the category which best describes the subject of your abstract on the basis of the topics listed (Categories: Cardiac Surgery, Cardiology).
- Indicate the preferred form of the presentation: oral or poster presentation.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ORAL PRESENTATION

Only presentation in Power Point will be allowed. Be sure to bring your presentation on a CD-rom or memory stick; floppy disks are not allowed; the use of personal lap-tops for presentation is discouraged.

The time for presentation will be 7 minutes + 3 minutes of discussion.

Material for presentation will be uploaded in the Speaker's Centre at least 2 hours before the presentation. We encourage you to check your presentation in the Speaker's Media Centre well in advance.

For the early morning sessions, please present your CD-rom at Speaker's Media Centre the day before.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

Posters must be brought in person by the author and should not be mailed in advance. The required size is 90 cm (width) x 140 cm (height). Illustrations must be produced heavily and clearly, so that all posters can be readable from a distance of 1.5 metres. At the top of the poster, in bold lettering of about 2.5 to 3 cm size, please provide the title of the paper, name(s) of the author (s), and affiliation.

The best posters will be selected for an oral mini presentation (5 minutes, 5 slides with the first reproducing the poster).







History

Opatija, often called the Nice of the Adriatic, is one of the most popular tourist resorts in Croatia and a place with the longest touristic tradition on the eastern coast of the Adriatic.

In 1844, Higinio Scarpa, a wealthy merchant and patrician from Rijeka, ordered a villa to be built for his wife Angiolina.

This signed the beginning of fame and fortune for this area where, according to the oldest written document, a Benedictine monastery was erected in 1453.

Opatija was so attractive that, at the end of the 19th and beginning of the 20th centuries, it was visited by the most prominent personalities of the European noble rank.

The royal families and the most distinguished members of the European upper class used to winter; Isadora Duncan was known to have here her 'secret shelter'.

In the 19th century several admirable buildings were erected, all of them echoing the Renaissance, Baroque and Neo-classicism architecture.

This made Opatija become the 'little Vienna' of tourism.

In 1858 doctor G.J.M. Sporer undertook an intense activity for Opatija to be recognized as a health and seaside resort.

His efforts were shared by Professor L. Schrötter-Kristelli (a distinguished representative of Vienna's School of Medicine who discovered a high concentration of aerosols in Opatija's air) and by an expert in balneotherapy, K. Carr; both praised the therapeutic properties of Opatija's climate, with the purpose of setting up a sanatorium and other health institutions.

A world-renowned surgeon from Vienna, Theodor Billroth (1828-1894), who used to spend his holidays in Opatija, confirmed the results of Professor Schrötter-Kristelli's studies, and predicted a brilliant future of therapeutic and seaside resort for Opatija.











CLIMATE

The Opatija's riviera is a unique combination of climatic opposites.

The average temperature in Opatija is some degrees higher than in the neighboring places, thus allowing successful growth of subtropic plants and camelias in its parks (the camelia has been chosen as the symbol of the town).

In Opatija you can swim until mid-October, the average temperature in early Autumn ranging between 23-25°C during the day.

At night the temperature is slightly lower, therefore warmer clothes are recommended.

WHAT TO DO IN OPATIJA

The Opatija riviera (25 km. long) is spread along the coast: you can rest on the beach or swim, take long walks along the seafront (20 km) or make excursions to the nearby mountains (up to 1400 m), going through the Mediterranean underbrush, evergreen and coniferous trees.

Tennis courts surrounded by a rich vegetation can be found all over the town.

In the numerous restaurants along the riviera one can taste both Mediterranean and Central-European cooking.


