## Clinical Research Post-doctorate Fellow: Cardiovascular Disease

The CCRC serves as a primary clinical coordinator center for major clinical trials. The CCRC is also engaged in numerous clinical trials as an enrolling site.

The post doctorate clinical research fellow will be involved in all aspects of research activities at the CCRC. Duties include:

- Maintaining a thorough working knowledge of all aspects of the CCRC protocols;
- Communicating with study committees, central labs and hospital departments as required;
- Writing manuscripts and preparing presentations related to trial and database activities;
- Organizing and participating in investigators/coordinators meetings;
- Traveling to required scientific and professional meetings;
- Participating in the development of medical students and house staff who rotate through the center; and
- Performing literature searches for publications including papers and chapters.
