The Richard I. Kaufman McGill Cardiovascular Scholars Fund and the Israel Heart Society Canadian Adult Congenital Heart Disease Fellowship

A. OBJECTIVES: To train a Cardiovascular Research Scholars with expertise in Adult Congenital Heart Disease (ACHD).

B. DESCRIPTION: A 2-year ACHD will be co-sponsored by McGill University and the Israel Heart Society (HIS). The fellowship will consist of 2 years of training with weekly ACHD clinics and clinical conferences with a focus on research throughout at the McGill Adult Clinic for Congenital Heart Disease in Montreal. The candidate will be expected submit 3 papers for publication along an integrated theme over the course 2 years. The candidate will be expected to return to an academic health center in Israel to contribute to leadership in ACHD in the country.

C. IMPLEMENTATION:

1. The award will be distributed given based on excellence in a **competition of applicants**. Applicants from all Israeli Universities will be invited to apply using a CV and letter of intent.
2. The ideal applicant will have a strong scholarly interest in developing a career in ACHD with a significant research component. Applications should be submitted to IHS by **August 1, 2019**.
3. An applicant will be chosen conjointly between the MAUDE leadership Dr. Ariane Marelli and Dr. Judith Therrien as well as the President of the Israel Heart Society.
4. The application at McGill for the academic year starting July 2020 would have to be submitted in the **Fall of 2019**.
5. This applicant will then be invited to submit a full application to McGill as per the instructions and specification on Page 2 of this document.
6. Applicants would be expected to present 1 paper each year at the **Israel Heart Society Meeting**.

D. FUNDING: The fellowship award includes 45K for living expenses in Montreal and 30k for tuition at McGill University per year. The Israel Heart Society will provide a total of 40K and the balance will be provided by McGill over the course of 2 years.
