He was a shining star in the IHS and Israeli cardiology world and a member of the JGH family as well, having completed 2 ½ years of very successful Fellowship training prior to returning to Soroka Medical Center. In his memory we have created an annual Fellowship, co-sponsored by his friends and colleagues on both sides of the ocean.
